- Current certification with Sonography Canada is required for the assigned practice area (such as, Generalist and/or Cardiac).
- Current certification with the American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers (ARDMS) is preferred for the assigned practice area (such as, Abdomen/Small Parts, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Cardiac, and/or Vascular).
- Eligibility for membership with Sonography Canada
- Provincial Instructors Diploma (PID) is preferred; willingness to complete PID is required

- Teaching experience in sonography education and diversity of employment experience, including administration and/or project work is preferred
- Comprehensive knowledge of theory and practice for Diagnostic Cardiac/General Sonography.
